

Minutes of Unit 206 Meeting May 21, 2024

In attendance – Richard Spangler, Margie Moses, Bruce Antman, Jim LaFevor, Mary Robertson, Jan Alexander.

Richard Spangler, President, called the meeting to order. The April 23, 2024 minutes were unanimously approved.

- Anne Donnovin, Chair of twice-a-month Monday night BBO Mentor/Mentee Game, reported the table count has decreased significantly, possibly due to a lack of interest. She recommended this game be postponed for a few months to give everyone a break and to set up some guidelines to use when this game recommences. There will be two meat choices and one vegetarian choice. The exact cost is not yet determined, but it is expected tournament participants will only be charged \$5.00 per sandwich with the CBC providing chips, coffee and soft drinks along with desserts for lunch Thursday

and Friday. Saturday lunch will be provided by the CBC and the menu will be decided in the future.

- Margie Moses has been receiving requests to re-start Monitored play of cards on Saturday from 10-12. She and Janie Hunt will reach out to all players to announce this opportunity beginning in June 2024.
